	be measured in 2023 the shipment was transferred to Southern Turkey for the Earthquake 2023
	response, aiding around 100,000 individuals. Additionally, health and nutrition programs in Kenya,
	Lebanon, Jordan, and Gaza supported vulnerable groups such as orphans, women, the elderly, and
	patients with chronic diseases. Notable was the collaboration with Mr Beast for vision restoration
	projects, enhancing the well-being of many.
